

## Cambridge 2024 SDG Summer Camp

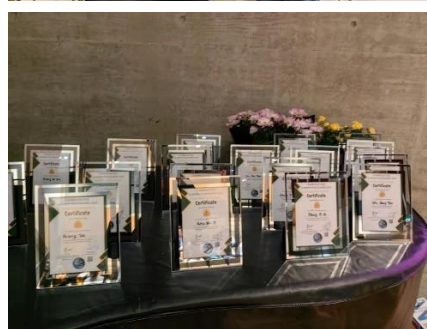

### July Group

- July 26th: Journey to Oxford to discover the unique charm of this ancient seat of learning.
- July 27th to 31st: Explore London, returning home on the 31st.

### August Group

- August 3rd: Set off towards London.
- August 4th: Arrive in London, commencing a fresh learning journey.
- August 5th to 9th: Participate in intensive SDG courses, engaging in intellectual exchanges with Cambridge scholars.
- August 10th: Travel to Oxford, experiencing the academic atmosphere of this city.
- August 11th to 15th: Delve deeper into the ancient metropolis of London, returning home on the 15th.

Day 4	Morning	Participate in the SDG International Program, covering British customs, etiquette, and cultural features.
	Afternoon	Play base ball to experience the joy of British sports.
Day 5	Morning	Engage in the SDG International Program, exploring current global issues such as climate change, population growth, and innovative technology.
	Afternoon	Explore the King's College, the Mathematical Bridge, Newton's Apple Tree, and the Corpus Clock, engaging in fun outdoor activities to complete special tasks.
Day 6	Morning	Participate in the SDG International Program, learning professional knowledge in fields like science and technology, and practicing to acquire practical skills.
	Afternoon	Visit the local music and arts center, learn about local artists, musicians, and cultural activities.
Day 7	Morning	Morning: Engage in the SDG International Program, participate in team summaries and discussions, Q&A, and share personal achievements.
	Afternoon	Join a team drama performance, attend the University of Cambridge formal dinner, hold a closing ceremony, and receive certificates with a speech from the professor.
Day 8	Morning	Return to London. Visit the streets and restaurants around central London and feel the unique charm of London.
	Afternoon	Excursion to financial city. Visit sky garden. Enjoy the sunset of London from the top of the sky skyscraper.
Day 9	Morning	Tower of London, a trip to Tower Bridge. Tour along the Thames on the south bank and visit London Bridge, the Fragment Building, Millennium Bridge, St. Paul's Cathedral.
	Afternoon	Tate Modern Museum, feel the most cutting-edge art trends and experience diversified art and enjoy.
Day 10	Morning	British Museum, a trip to world history. British National Gallery, visit world art relics and enjoy the top of art.
	Afternoon	South Kingston, Victoria & Albert Museum, complete mission-based exploration activities.



Day 11	Morning	Madame Tussauds, London, watch wax statues of celebrities from all over the world, participate in interesting shooting activities, and experience wonderful stars International War Theme Park.
	Afternoon	Regent's Park visit and picnic activities. Regent Street, Bond Street, Oxford Street, experience the British shopping paradise.
